Terms & Conditions

Literary Works

1. Only the literary works of writers of the Indian Diaspora countries will be published in this anthology.
2. Writers are requested to send only one original and unpublished work in any literary genre. More than one submission may be considered in case of poems and anecdotes (*Laghukatha*).

Research Papers & Critical Analysis

1. Research Papers on Diaspora Hindi Literature should be between 2000-2500 words.
2. Research Papers may be sent by academics/researchers from the Indian Diaspora as well any other country.
3. Research Papers should be referenced as per acceptable referencing norms and include a bibliography.

General Rules

1. Literary works/research papers will be published only upon the approval of the editorial panel.
2. Writers/Researchers are requested to send along with their submission, a note certifying that *the literary work/research paper sent for publication is original and unpublished*.
3. Writers/Researchers are requested to send along with their submission, a brief bio data (100 words) and a passport size photograph.
4. Submissions should be in Hindi and Devnagri Script.
5. Submissions should be typed in Unicode.
6. Submissions by email should be both in MS Word and PDF versions.
7. Submissions can also be made in hard copies and sent to the address mentioned below.
8. Submissions should reach the Mahatma Gandhi Institute at latest on 30 April, 2018.
