## Conditionalities and Criteria

### 1. Eligibility

The Award is open to practising teachers who teach learners in a formal school setting.

### 2. Assessment:

Applicants for the Award are expected to submit tangible evidence (Portfolio, Photographs, Videos, etc.) to back up their Motivation Letter.

Applicants should provide evidence with regard to the following:

- Contribution to the achievement of pupils'/students' learning outcomes
  - Use of both effective and innovative as well as scalable teaching practices, including through the use of technology
  - Recognition by Peers and Head(s) of School (as well as community) of the achievements highlighted
  - Involvement of the community in the classroom
  - Contribution to the holistic development of learners and their broader exposure to Hindi language and literature
  - Any form of recognition from outside the school with regards to Hindi, if any
  - Support extended to other teachers in the development of their skills as well as the mentoring of new teachers
  - Participation in any capacity building programme/seminar/workshop as speaker/resource person
3. During the assessment Candidates are to expect in-class visits as well as face-to-face interactions with a team of Assessors.
